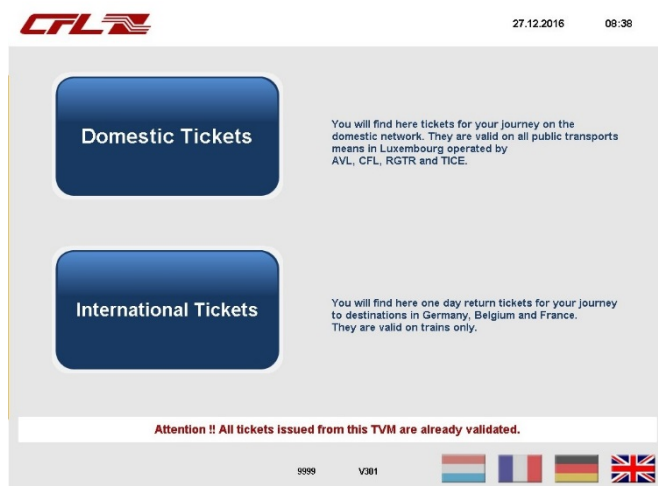


## How to buy your tickets from CFL ticket vending machines

On the CFL ticket vending machines, you:

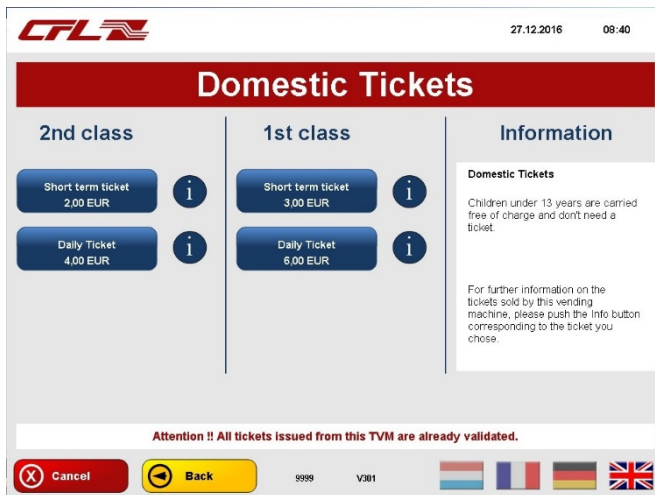
- 1 - Select the product
- 2 - Insert Cash/Card
- 3 - Retrieve the printed tickets and the change (if applicable)



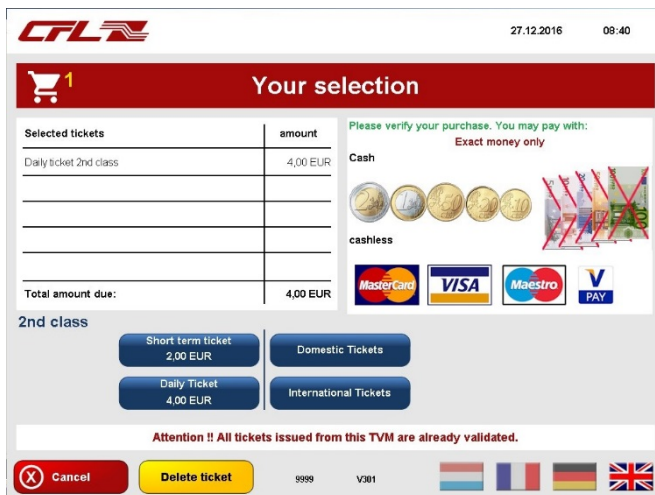
On the main screen, you may choose your language by touching the corresponding country flag, and then you may choose between domestic tickets and international tickets by touching the corresponding soft button.



If you have chosen international tickets, you continue by choosing your destination or the product group. The destinations are grouped by country.



The next step is to choose the exact ticket. This step comes right after the main screen for domestic tickets, and comes after the choice of the destination for international tickets. The products are listed per travel class, and for adult and children if applicable. The ticket vending machine only proposes a selection of products (\*).



Once the first ticket has been selected, the shopping cart is displayed, and you can either proceed by choosing more products, or proceed to check-out. Once the tickets have been paid (by Euro coins, by Visa or Mastercard credit cards, by Vpay or Maestro debit cards, or for some ticket vending machines by Euro bills), the tickets are printed and you may retrieve them in the ticket/change slot at the bottom of the machine.

(\*) The following products are available on the CFL ticket vending machines: domestic 2h-ticket, domestic day ticket, one day return tickets for Arlon, Gouvy, Vielsalm, Trois-Ponts, Thionville, Metz, Nancy and Trier for both adults and children, and the Rheinland-Pfalz-Ticket Plus Luxembourg product.
